

OCPS Cell Phone Policy

- HCES is following the OCPS Cell Phone Policy as listed below.
- OCPS requires that wireless communications device(s)* be silenced and put away (in a backpack or purse) during the school day while on campus, including lunchtime and transitioning between classes.
- *Wireless communication devices include but are not limited to, cell phones and/or auxiliary/ancillary devices such as watches and ear buds.
- The following actions will be taken if a student violates OCPS' cell phone policy:
 - Confiscation (Item returned at the end of the day)
 - Detention
 - Positive Alternative to School Suspension (PASS)
 - Out-of-School Suspension (OSS)
 - Pursuant to the Technology in K-12 Public Schools law that took effect on July 1, 2023 and Section 1006.07, Florida Statutes.

Instructional Shifts in OCPS



The Science of Reading is research from thousands of studies that tells us about how people learn to read.



Reading Comprehension is an approach to reading instruction that is explicit, systematic, cumulative, sequential and multisensory.

OCPS is creating a stronger alignment with the Science of Reading through explicit instruction for both word recognition and language comprehension to help students become successful readers.

- Read different types of books
- Ask questions before, during, and after reading
- Play word games
- Discuss new words included in the text
- Ask your child's teacher for more tips
